WP6 & WP7 Regional Detention Structures

Project Progress

This is the third annual report. Work prior to December 15, 2016 included preliminary design services and beginning land acquisition however, these costs are not included in the grant. Only work and activities after December 15, 2016 were included in the application. From March 2018 through March 2019 the land rights were completed and construction of the two reservoirs has begun. The first phase of the embankment for WP6 was completed this winter as well as tree removal and initial work at WP7. The projects are about 15% complete.

Project Related Activities for 2019

Construction of WP6 and WP7 is anticipated to continue throughout the next year and in to the following year. The substantial completion date of the construction contract is September 30, 2020.

Total projected costs for 2019 \$6,409,682 (60% from WSF=\$3,845,809)

Remaining costs in 2020 are projected at \$3,204,694 (60% from WSF=\$1,922,816)
