# West Branch Papillion Creek Regional Detention Structure WP-1

## Project Progress

The WSF agreement was approved March 15, 2019. Work prior to December 18, 2018 which included preliminary design services is not included in the grant. From March 2019 through March 2020 the majority of the work on this project was a watershed plan update funded through the Natural Resources Conservation Service. Minimal final design to address some power pole relocation and an access drive was completed in this period. One land acquisition was completed in February 2019. The watershed plan update is expected to be complete in the summer of 2020. The project is 5% complete.

### Project Related Activities through 2020

Watershed planning with federal partners and final design of the WP-1 basin is anticipated to continue throughout 2020. Land acquisition will also occur in 2020 and some final design and permitting of the project. Estimated costs do not include federal funding.
