This letter outlines the annual progress report for the Water Sustainability Fund (WSF) Grant #5218, titled Western Water Use Management Model Update and Extension (WWUMM Update and Extension). The WWUMM Update and Extension is on track with progress on the modeling. The primary tasks that are currently in progress or have been completed are listed below:

- 1. North Platte and South Platte Surface Water Modeling In Progress
- 2. Reinterpretation of the Brule Formation fractured aquifer system along Pumpkin Creek and Lodgepole Creek Completed
- 3. Refinements to the geology and hydrogeology of the Southern Tablelands Completed
- 4. Unstructured Grids Ground Water Modeling Update In Progress
- 5. Update Modeling with LiDAR Data In Progress
- 6. Refinement of Surface Water Land Use; Update and Extend Land Use through 2020 In Progress
- 7. Update and Extend the Models through 2020 In Progress
- 8. Coordination with DNR modeling staff and documentation of the modeling update In Progress

The work is being completed within the project's timeline and we anticipate the entire project will be completed by June 2021.

The total project budget is \$400,000, with WFS contributing \$240,000 and the South Platte and North Platte Natural Resources Districts contributing \$160,000. To date, the project has spent \$354,136.25.
