PROJECT PROGRESS APRIL 2016 TO March 2020:

- From April 2019 to present, the LENRD provided cost share at a rate of \$500 or \$250 per meter for 44 meters, a total of \$20,000. Total cost share provided since beginning the project is \$1,403,250 for 2906 meters. All approved applications have been paid, and the project is ready to be closed out.
- The LENRD has hosted trainings on the correct installation of flow meters on an as-needed basis for individuals.
- The LENRD has additionally paid for inspections of approximately 1,870 existing meters.
- The LENRD has spent approximately \$200,000 each year for cost sharing a wide variety of water and soil conservation practices and nutrient management practices.
- An online reporting tool for annual flow meter readings is available for use by producers, and all producers are required to submit their readings at the end of each irrigation season.
